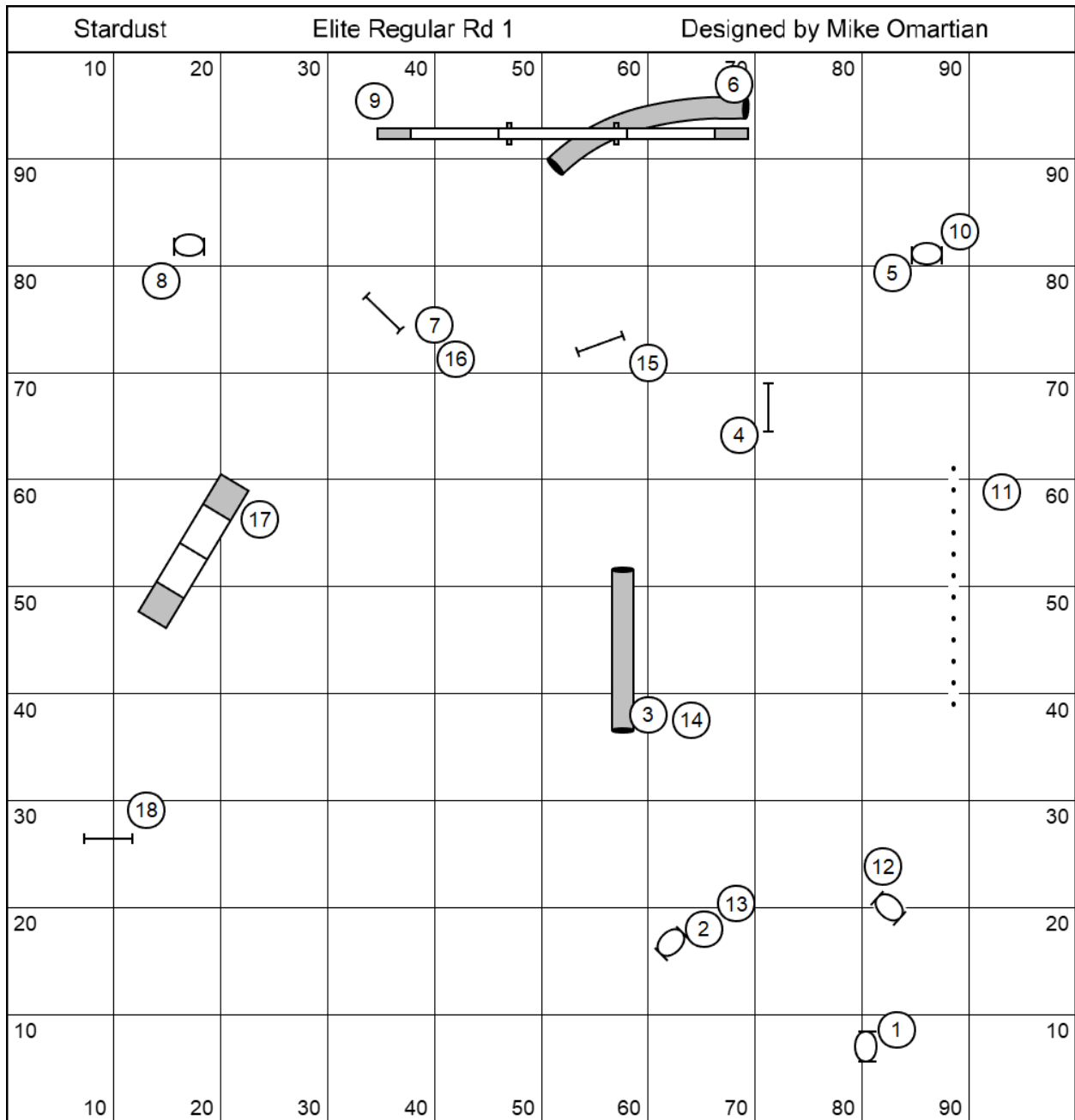

Stardust Open Regular Rd 1 Designed by Mike Omartian
